What Does This Mean for You?

- You will no longer need to schedule an appointment in advance for your allergy injections. You will simply be able to walk in during designated dates and times to receive your injections.
- We hope this gives you the freedom and flexibility to choose a time that works best for you and your family. This change will make it easier and more convenient for you to continue receiving your allergy care!
- Please be patient with us during this transition, as you may experience additional wait times during peak hours as we adjust, such as lunchtimes or right after school/work, etc.

How Will I Know About Schedule Changes?

- Dates and times are subject to change and will be reflected on our location page on our website at allervie.com.
- You may also call our office directly for the latest information. As a reminder, we may not be able to give you an accurate idea of how busy we may be at a given time.
- If we have an emergency that results in closing or temporarily changing shot clinic hours, we will post a notice on the front door and update our digital platforms as best we can to ensure you are informed of those instances.

What Are the Cut-Off Times for Shots?

- The last shot will be administered 30 minutes before closing. The times listed before lunch and at the end of the day are the last possible time to receive a walk-in injection. We highly recommend arriving a few minutes before this to ensure we can accommodate you.

Will This Affect Biologic Injections?

- The above policy change does NOT include Biologic injections (Xolair, Fasenra, Nucala, Tezspire, etc.).
- These must continue to be scheduled by the front desk (via phone or in office) at least 5 business days in advance at your request.

What If I Normally Receive Both a Biologic Injection and an Allergy Injection at the Same Visit?

- You will continue to schedule these with the front desk.
